EPA-registered Avocet® is a systemic aquatic herbicide that provides excellent control of emergent weeds in all bodies of fresh and brackish water, whether flowing, non-flowing or transient. Avocet is effective in other non-crop areas such as landscape, industrial, recreational or public sites, and is even recommended for restoration and maintenance of native

habitat and wildlife management areas. Avocet controls many emergent and floating aquatic plants, plus terrestrial and ditchbank woody brush, grasses and weeds. Use it as a broadcast spray, wick/wiper, cut-stump treatments, or inject and frill applications on nuisance woody brush.

Directions For Use:

Mix with clean water, and apply to foliage of plant to be controlled. Applications must be as spray-to-wet, with complete and uniform coverage. To control labeled annual weeds, apply a ¾ to 2% solution of Avocet plus proper amount of nonionic surfactant. When less than complete coverage is expected, use a 5% Avocet solution for control of annual and perennial weeds, and 5–8% solution for woody brush and trees. Cut-stump treatments require a 50–100% solution of Avocet; frill and inject treatments a 25–100% solution.
